

Expert Declaration

- 1.0 My full name is Warren Scott Page, and I was born in Baltimore Maryland. I work as the lead video engineer for Kustom Signals, Inc. My official title is Senior Project Engineer. I have full credentials for my position, as well as many years of managing engineering development teams. I have been degreed as an electrical Engineer since 1990. I have been developing both analog and digital video systems for law enforcement since 2001, and am a recognized expert in digital video systems, structures, methodologies and analysis. My additional professional experience includes development in the telecommunications field, reliability engineering, and microwave design and development.
- 2.0 I have done analysis on hundreds of law enforcement video recordings, both analog and digital in nature. I have been a member of the IACP Digital Video Standards Committee to determine minimum system requirements for both in-car digital video systems and back office storage systems designed for law enforcement applications. I have personally led design teams in the development of 5 different in-car video recording systems designed for Law Enforcement applications, and have designed hardware and software on all of these systems as the lead engineer. I am recognized internationally as a subject matter expert in Digital Video
- 3.0 I have gained considerable experience as both a court appointed expert witness, and as a consultant in the analysis of both analog and digital video.
